




Class Highlights Ms. Dionne's Class

Last Week: The children began exploring this term's theme:
All About Me. They participated in fun settling-in games
such as Getting to Know You, and their activities were
linked to self-awareness and identity.

This Week: Students were introduced to the letter s (Jolly Phonics Set 1), practiced counting to 10, and learned about the math concept of bigger/smaller by sorting strawberries into baskets. This was integrated into their English lesson. They also discovered the color red, the number 1, the shape square, and the letter A (both upper and lowercase). Next Week: Students will revise the letters s and a. They will also be introduced to a new color (orange), the number 2, and a new shape (triangle). A busy, exciting week is ahead!

Children brought their favorite teddy bears from home for a delightful show and tell. It was heartwarming to see them share their stories and cuddle with their bears.






Special Days Watermelon Day:


Upcoming Events (September)

- 30th Sept Community Helper Day Visit from Local Police A fun, interactive session on the role of our community helpers.






Reminders
